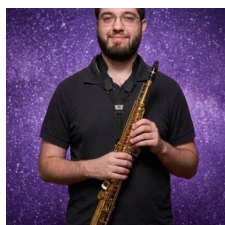

FOUNDER, MANAGER & TENOR SAXOPHONE

Rich is a retired CT public school music educator. He taught all levels of instrumental and vocal music in multiple districts for 35 years, the last 26 being in Cheshire, CT. Rich earned Bachelor and Master of Science degrees in Music Education from Central CT State University, and also holds a Master of Science degree in Addiction Counseling from Grand Canyon University, Phoenix, AZ. During his undergrad years, Rich played alto saxophone as his main instrument and was a section leader and soloist in both his university wind and jazz ensembles, as well as the New England Intercollegiate Honor Band. In 1997, Rich had the opportunity to perform at Carnegie Hall with the Connecticut Symphonic Band. He has also served as a music minister and music director at area churches, and sings tenor with the Asylum Hill Congregational Church Sanctuary Choir, Hartford, CT, as well as seasonally with the Chamber Choir at Holy Family Passionist Retreat Center, West Hartford, CT. Rich is currently a program coordinator for The City School of the Arts/Charter Oak Cultural Center, Hartford, CT, and is especially proud of founding, managing, and playing tenor saxophone with The Infinity Saxophone Quartet.

He went on to study music at the University of Bridgeport, graduating Summa Cum Laude with Bachelor of Arts and Science degrees in Saxophone Music Performance and Music Education. Steve then completed a 2-year national tour with the Tommy Dorsey Orchestra led by Buddy Morrow, taught at Green Farms Academy, and served as an adjunct professor at Fairfield University. He currently works as a freelance musician, playing all types of saxophones as well as clarinet, flute, piano, and singing.
